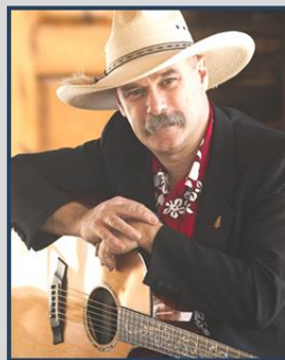

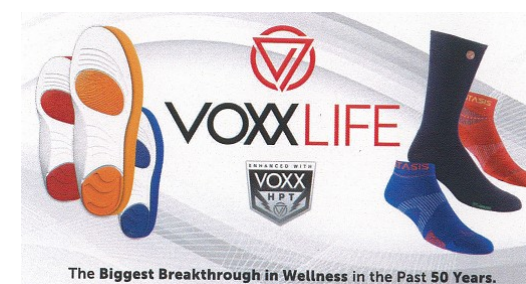

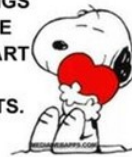

Please join us for Easter service on April 21 to celebrate the Jesus' sacrifice for each and every one of us.

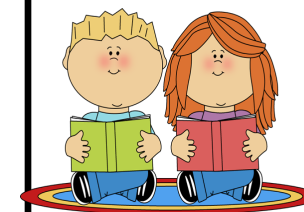
