Taxes can be paid monthly by automatic withdrawal or by cheque. Please sign up at the Village Office before January 15, 2020.

Receive a 4% discount on your taxes by paying in full by January 31, 2020. The amount will be the 2019 Tax Levy as the 2020 Tax Levy will not be calculated until May.

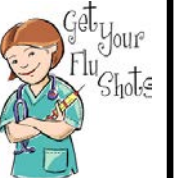

These gifts may be dropped off at the Delburne Village office or Servus Credit Union on or before noon on **Monday, December 16th/19**



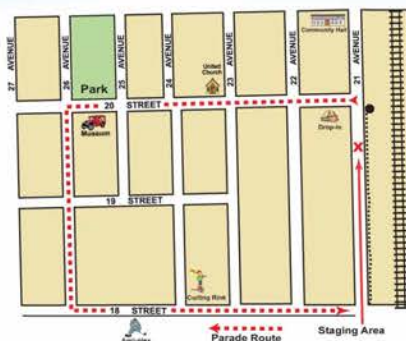

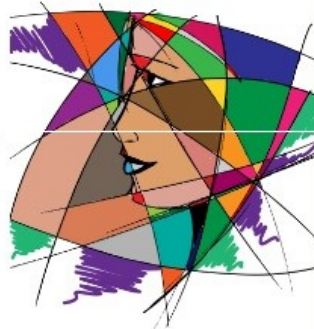

What is the FCSS Snow Angels Program?

The Snow Angels Program aims to encourage neighbours to help one another and thereby build a caring, engaged community. Residents in need of snow removal have "Snow Angels" signs placed on their yards or in their windows.

Who is eligible to have a Snow Angels sign?

Residents who need assistance removing snow are eligible. This may be older adults, a person with mobility issues, or a person who is convalescing. The Snow Angels Program relies on the good will of neighbourhood volunteers. Placement of a Snow Angel sign is not a guarantee that snow will be removed.

Who are Snow Angels?

Snow Angels are individuals: youth, seniors, families and community groups who voluntarily shovel snow for residents needing snow removal assistance.

Where can I get a sign?

Residents wanting a Snow Angels sign can stop by FCSS at the Village Office or call Carol 749-3654.

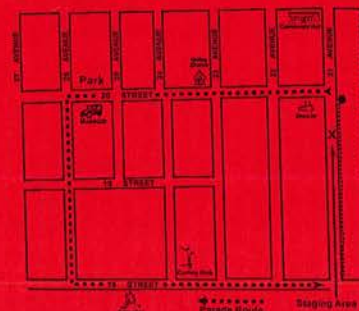

2020 Dog Licenses

If you live in Delburne & own a dog, you must have a dog license!

Dog License Fees

Neutered	\$15.00
Unaltered	\$35.00

There is a penalty of **\$10.00** per dog license if renewed after January 31, 2020.

There is a maximum of 3 dogs per owner!

Dog License Fines

Owner of an unlicensed dog	\$200.00
Providing False Information	\$100.00
Owner of licensed dog not wearing license tag while off owner's property	\$50.00
Owner of a dog at large	\$100.00

2020 Business Licenses

If you are operating a business in Delburne, you are required to have a business license.

Business License Fees

Local Business	\$50.00
Local Non-Resident (<i>within 60 km of Delburne</i>)	\$50.00
Non-Resident	\$100.00
Home Occupation	\$25.00

Business License Bylaw #847

16a. Any person contravening any provision of this bylaw shall be liable upon conviction therefore to a fine not less than \$250.00 and not more than \$1,000.00 exclusive of costs.
16b. Where the offense is non-payment of any license fee payable hereunder, the convicting provincial judge may adjudge payment thereof in addition to the fine imposed.

Property Taxes

With 2019 coming to a close, the Village of Delburne would like to remind property owners to verify that they do not have an outstanding balance on their property taxes.

"In the event any outstanding balance is not paid on or before December 31 in any year, there shall be added a penalty of 10% on January 1 of the following year."

- The Tax Penalty Bylaw No. 1136/2018

2020 Property Tax Payment Plans

We have payment plans to make it easier for you to pay your property taxes.

Receive a **4%** discount on your taxes by paying in full between **January 1 - 31, 2020**

Tax Discount Program

Between January 1, 2020 - January 31, 2020 property owners can sign up for the tax discount program.

- Properties with an outstanding tax balance are not eligible for the prepayment discount. Tax arrears must be paid in full before taking advantage of the 2020 prepaid tax discount.
- The discount rate shall be calculated at 4.0% of the 2019 year tax levy. If the tax levy changes due to assessment changes or mill rate changes, the difference will be reflected in the tax notice payable on June 30, 2020.

Monthly Tax Installment Plan

Starting January 1, 2020, property owners can sign up for the monthly tax installment plan. Deadline to register to pay with cheques is January 14, 2020. Deadline to register to pay by automatic withdrawal is January 24, 2020.

- To do the monthly tax installment plan, taxes in arrears and penalties must be paid up first.
- Landowners must fill out and sign a Tax Installment Payment Plan form.
- For January - June, the monthly payment amount will be calculated using the 2019 Tax Levy and then payments for July - December will be adjusted using the 2020 Tax Levy.
- Payments can be made with post-dated cheques or through automatic account withdrawal
- Payments by cheque will be deposited on the 15th day of every month starting January 15, 2020.
- Payments by automatic account withdrawal will be processed on the last day of each month.
