

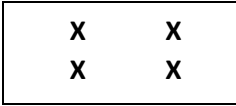


Burial Procedures

F A Q's:

- The operation of the Delburne Cemetery is in accordance with the established policies and procedures by the Village and in accordance with the Alberta Cemeteries Act.
- A copy of the current Village of Delburne Cemetery bylaw will be included with this Burial Procedure information.
- The Village of Delburne must approve all work done in the cemetery.
- Gravediggers are Jack Martens 403-318-3113 or Kyle Marek 403-358-2382.
- Memorials: Mr. Monument (Boyd Gilbert) from Red Deer and Delburne at 403-341-4784. Legacy Monuments in Red Deer Gasoline Alley (Darwin Parcels) at 403-340-3426. Other memorial services may be used.
- Interment will only be permitted once a BURIAL PERMIT has been submitted to the Village of Delburne Cemetery Caretaker.
- Payment of \$200 + GST must be received by the Village Office before burial.
- At least 48 hours is needed in advance for cemetery services (marking the burial plot).
- Only one headstone marker is allowed and must be placed at the head of the plot (typically in line with others in the same row). Please see Monument Regulations in the attached Cemetery Bylaw.
- A ground level urn marker can be placed over an urn burial. If the marker is not at ground level it will be removed.
- Up to two Urn burials are permitted over an existing casket burial if space is adhered to. Refer to the current Delburne Cemetery bylaw.
- Up to four Urn burials are permitted without a casket burial (two at the head & two at the feet).



- The recording of Urn placement is very important. Please contact the Village of Delburne Cemetery Caretaker for placement.
