### Funding Guideline Policy

The Delburne Community Support Grants' mandate is to support youth, family, adult and community recreation, culture and programming, and community development for not for profit organizations. Also to be included are capital, maintenance, and the operations of facilities.

\* Applications are received twice annually. Deadlines are Spring intake is March 15 **NO EXCEPTIONS**. Applications are available at the Village office or on our website.

\* Funds must be spent and accounted for as approved by the Board. Accounting of Grant Funds form must be completed and submitted with copies of receipts to the Village office once the funds have been spent.

\* Applications that show efforts by other means will be looked at more favorably.

\* As grant funds are limited, it is the Delburne Community Support Grant mandate to ensure that all applicants have equal access to monies over time.

had an active fall. On October 26th an open house was hosted in Lousana with about 50 attendees being welcomed by President Ray Miller. Guest speaker was Devin Dreeshen, MLA Innisfail /Sylvan Lake, who pointed out, "We are trying to rehabilitate the unrehabilitable" as 80% of crime is done by 20% of the people.

Red Deer County Peace Officers, Stephan Poburan and Brad Olsen gave a presentation, Crime Through Environmental Design (CPTED). The county has trained officers that will go to rural land/ homeowners residences to perform CPTED assessments free of charge and advise changes that make your property safer and less inviting to the thief.
