

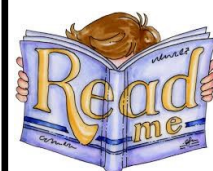

We operate with funding from the Ministry of Children's Services and donations from our local groups and organizations. We are overseen by a volunteer board of 8 members. We meet once a month to review and discuss pertinent information regarding our community and Neighborhood Place operation.

Drop In Centre Games Day on Feb. 13th



This group of students is our Grade 6 class. There are 33 children in the grade. Joining the seniors to play games is part of our CTF course. CTF stands for Career and Technology Foundations. CTF is designed for students to explore their interests, their passions, and their skills to help make personal connections to future career possibilities. The students in grades 7, 8 and 9 are also offered the CTF program.

The next biggest project the Grade 6 students will be preparing for is called Food Truck Friday. This project will have the students plan, organize, prepare and serve a menu of food from a model Food Truck that they have built.

The grade 7 and 8 students will be preparing, planning, marketing, and building Soap Box cars for the school's annual Soap Box Derby.

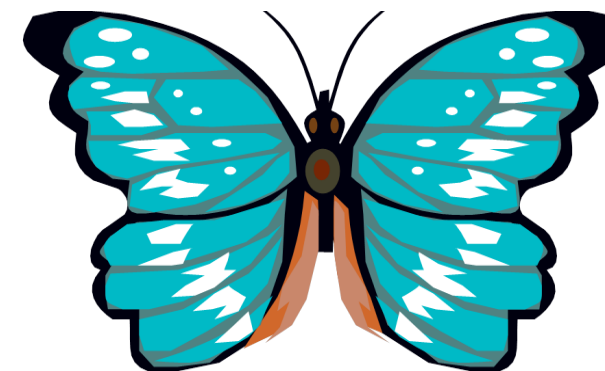
