Section 3.5 of Bylaw No. 1166/2020, being the
Responsible Pet Ownership Bylaw, states:

*"If a dog defecates on any public or private
property other than the property of its Owner,
the Owner shall cause such defecation to be
removed immediately."*

Help Keep Our Sewers Clean

Fats, oils and grease can create blockages in your house's sewer lines and
the Village's main lines. Keeping drains fat-free is easy as 1, 2, 3!

1. Pour grease into an aluminum can or heat-safe container, not down the drain.
When cool, dispose of grease in the garbage.
2. Scrape any food remains into the garbage before rinsing the dishes.
3. Catch any scraps of food in a sink strainer.

If paid between January 1 - 31, 2023 the fees are:

Fixed pet: \$15.00

Unaltered pet: \$30.00

A replacement tag & new number is \$5.00.

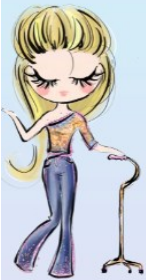
