



Thank you to everyone that attended the kitchen demonstration that FCSS brought in last month. Here is one of their favourite recipes.

BANGKOK BEAN CURRY



ATCO

BLUE FLAME

KITCHEN

- 1 tbsp (15 mL) oil
- 1 cup (250 mL) chopped onion
- 2 cloves garlic, finely chopped
- 3 4 tsp (15 20 mL) red curry paste
- 1 can (28 oz / 796 mL) red kidney beans, rinsed and drained
- 1 can (14 oz / 398 mL) diced tomatoes
- 1 can (400 mL) coconut milk
- 2 tbsp (25 mL) sugar
- 1 tsp (5 mL) grated lime peel
- 1/2 tsp (2 mL) salt
- 2 tbsp (25 mL) fresh lime juice
- Hot cooked rice
- Thinly sliced green onion

Heat oil in a large saucepan over medium heat. Add onion and sauté for 5 minutes. Stir in garlic and red curry paste; sauté for 1 minute. Stir in beans, tomatoes, coconut milk, sugar, lime peel and salt. Bring to a boil. Reduce heat and simmer, uncovered, stirring occasionally, for 30 minutes. Stir in lime juice. Serve over rice and sprinkle with green onion. Serves 4 - 6.


