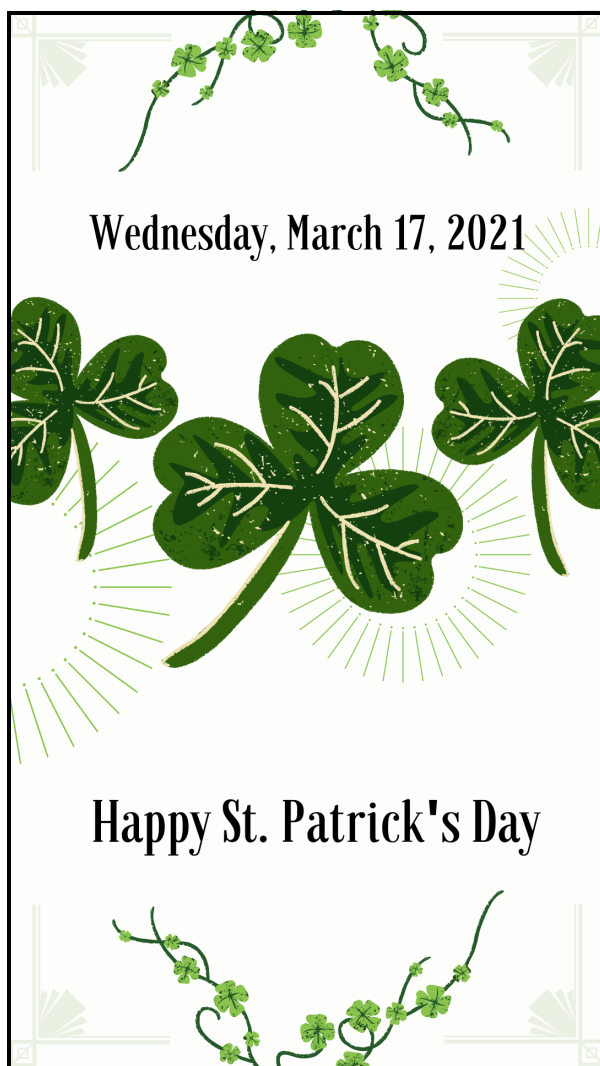

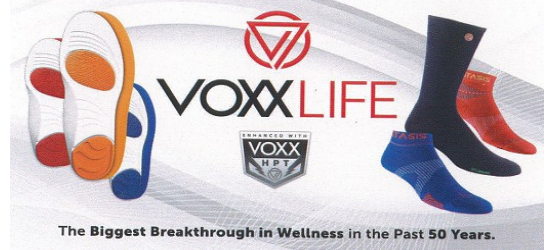

If you see a hazardous driver swerving or driving erratically:

- Safely pull over away from traffic with your hazard lights on
- Call 9-1-1
- Provide as many details as you can, including the direction in which the car was going, the street it was on, and the make and model of the vehicle. The licence plate number can help too.

Do NOT call 9-1-1 if you spot someone using their phone who is not displaying dangerous driving behaviour. Instead, call the RCMP non-emergency line to report it.

Help Reduce Distracted Driving

Distracted driving includes anything that...

- Takes your eyes off the road
- Hands off the wheel
- Mind off the task

The penalty for distracted driving in Alberta is a \$300 fine and 3 demerit points.
