

Council Considering 40 km/hr Speed Limit Throughout Village

The topic of speed limits in Delburne was on the agenda at the July 13th council meeting as some residents have made requests for the speed limit on 18th St. to be decreased to 30 km/hr. Last year, Council reduced the speed limit for the entire length of Main St. (20th St.) to 30 km/hr which resulted in a mixed reaction from the community.

Council would like to consider implementing a 40 km/hr speed limit throughout the Village of Delburne, excluding school and playground zones which would remain at 30 km/hr. Other Central Alberta municipalities such as Sylvan Lake and Blackfalds have already implemented a 40 km/hr speed limit to help reduce collisions and make the streets safer for drivers, cyclists, and pedestrians. Council will be seeking public opinion through a survey which will be mailed out with utility bills during the first week of August. Feedback can also be provided by emailing village@delburne.ca.

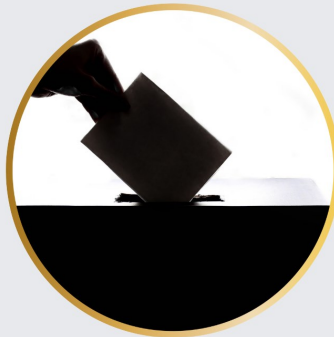

Emailing Utility Bills

The second month of emailing utility bills was successful! In August, if you have signed up for e-billing, we will not be sending an additional mailed paper copy since our testing phase is now over.

Please note:

Only property owners will be sent a utility bill. It is the responsibility of the property owner to ensure the utility bill is paid.

If you rent out your property, we recommend that you include utilities into the rental fee to avoid your account from being in arrears and having the balance transferred to property taxes with a \$50 administration fee, as per *The Water, Sewer & Garbage Bylaw #1124/2016*.

Please Pick up after your Pooch

We have received feedback that dog owners have not been picking up after their dogs on RR 233 (10th Ave) which is within the Village limits. Please help keep our community clean. The *Responsible Pet Ownership Bylaw #1166/2020, section 3.5* states:

"If a dog defecates on any public or private property other than the property of its Owner, the Owner shall cause such defecation to be removed immediately. The Owner shall be responsible for carrying the necessary apparatus to remove the offending substance."
