

### Council Approves To Keep The Yard Waste Trailer

Council has approved to keep the yard waste trailer and yard waste disposal services at the Dry Dump after receiving feedback from residents greatly supporting the services. Large compost bins will be rented by the Village to be stored at the Dry Dump with a \$1.50 yard waste recycling fee added to monthly utility bills over a 12 month period. This fee will cover the cost of renting the compost bins and it will pay for the tipping fees to remove the yard waste when the bins are full.

Alberta Environment will no longer allow the municipality to burn yard waste at the Dry Dump therefore an alternative was needed to dispose of organic material. Residents were in great favour of keeping the yard waste trailer with some comments noting that a second trailer is needed. Council is considering adding the purchase of a larger dump trailer to the 2023 Budget. The yard waste trailer will be put out in May and the monthly yard waste disposal fee will be applied for May's utility services which are invoiced at the beginning of June.

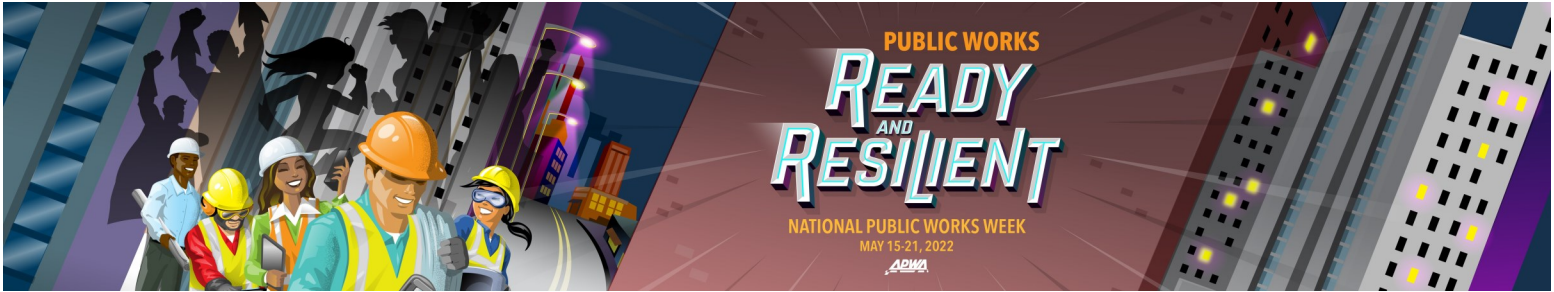
The Dry Dump will not take animal feces, treated lumber, kitchen waste, firepit ashes, household garbage and commercial/industrial waste.

## Council Passes 2022 Tax Rate Bylaw

Delburne Council passed Bylaw No. 1178/2022, the 2022 Tax Rate Bylaw, at the April 26th meeting. For 2022, there will be zero increase in the municipal tax rate however the provincial requisitions have increased. Property owners will be able to view the rates when the 2022 Combined Assessment and Notices are mailed out near the end of May.

At the April 26th meeting, Council made a motion to direct Administration to consult with Red Deer County regarding Bylaw No. 1177/2022, being the Land Use Bylaw Amendment to include the Fawn Meadows Estates. Previously, a Public Hearing was held on April 12th to hear feedback from residents regarding the proposed bylaw with only four property owners providing their opinions on the matter.

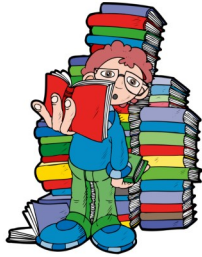

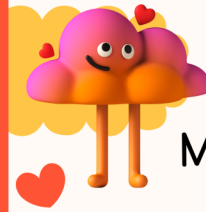

### Campfire Season is Here! Make sure that you have an acceptable fire pit!



A fire pit must be 3 metres away from a building, property line and combustible materials. It must have enclosed sides which are made of brick, concrete or metal. The fire pit must be equipped with a mesh screen with an opening no larger than 12.5 mm. The height of the fire pit must not exceed 0.6 metres when measured from the surrounding grade to the top of the pit opening.

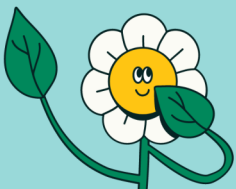

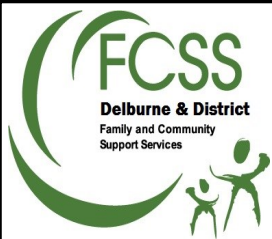
