

Dry Dump Renamed the Delburne Eco Station

At the May 9th Council meeting, a motion was made to rename the Delburne Dry Dump to the **Delburne Eco Station** because the former name creates the confusion that household garbage and commercial waste are accepted at the site.

Last year, Alberta Environment informed the municipality that burning cannot take place at the then-named Dry Dump, so the solution was to rent large compost bins to collect yard waste and then have it hauled away when full. In the next few weeks, Public Works will be ordering signs to reflect the new name. The Delburne Eco Station accepts organic material and recyclable items, including electronic waste (items with freon will not be accepted). Spring/Summer operating hours are now in effect with the Delburne Eco Station being open Tuesdays and Thursdays from 3 pm - 6 pm and Saturdays from 9 am - 3 pm. The station is located at 2001 10th Ave (Range Road 233 on the East side of Fawn Meadows Golf Course).

2022 Combined Assessment & Tax Notices Mailed Out

The 2022 Combined Assessment and Tax Notices have been mailed out to property owners. Property taxes are due by **Thursday, June 30, 2022**. After July 1, 2022, a 15% late penalty will be applied to any outstanding balance on current taxes.

COMMERCIAL VEHICLE SAFETY REMINDER

The Alberta RCMP reminds road users of the following safety tips:

COMMERCIAL VEHICLE DRIVERS

- Leave enough following distance between you and vehicles in front of you.
- If you are transporting a load, ensure that it is properly secured.
- Regularly check your blind spots for smaller vehicles.
- Pull over when feeling tired as it could save your life or someone else's.
- Remember to complete proper trip inspections to ensure your vehicle is in good operating condition.

PASSENGER VEHICLE DRIVERS

- Stay far enough behind big trucks so that they can see you in both side mirrors on the truck. If you can't see the truck driver, they can't see you.
- Leave extra space when passing or changing lanes in front of commercial vehicles as they require more time to slow down or come to a stop.
- Stay back when large vehicles are indicating right or left, as they require a large turning radius.

Any assessed person(s) who has/have not received their 2022 Assessment and Tax Notice(s) should contact the municipal office during regular business hours for a copy.

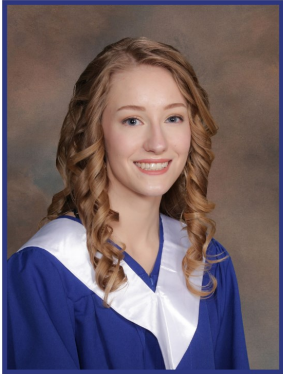

Your financial institution can freeze your account and put an alert on usage to prevent a fraudster from taking any of your money.



DON'T LET ANYONE USE YOUR MOBILE DEVICES

Information can be stolen from computers and phones.



BE CAUTIOUS WHEN USING PUBLIC INTERNET CONNECTIONS

Only use websites that start with "https://" because this indicates that you are on a secure site.
