# Village of Delburne Information

## Reminder: Trapping of Cats Requires Permission From Animal Control

Multiple complaints have been made that some residents have been trapping and disposing of cats on their own. Bylaw No. 1166/2020, the Responsible Pet Ownership Bylaw, states that no one is allowed to trap without signing the Cat Trap Agreement with our Animal Control Bylaw Officer. The humane handling of cats is important when trapping and Animal Control has a cat trapping policy which they will go over with a resident who wants to trap a cat that is trespassing on their property.

As per Schedule C, Section 11 of Bylaw No. 1166/2020: "Any person who abuses, teases, or pokes an animal in a cat trap or is causing pain, suffering, or injury to any animal may be charged with an offence under Section 446 of the Criminal Code of Canada."

Cats must be registered with the Village of Delburne and they are not allowed to be running at large or defecating on other people's property as per Section 5.1 and 5.2 of the Responsible Pet Ownership Bylaw. 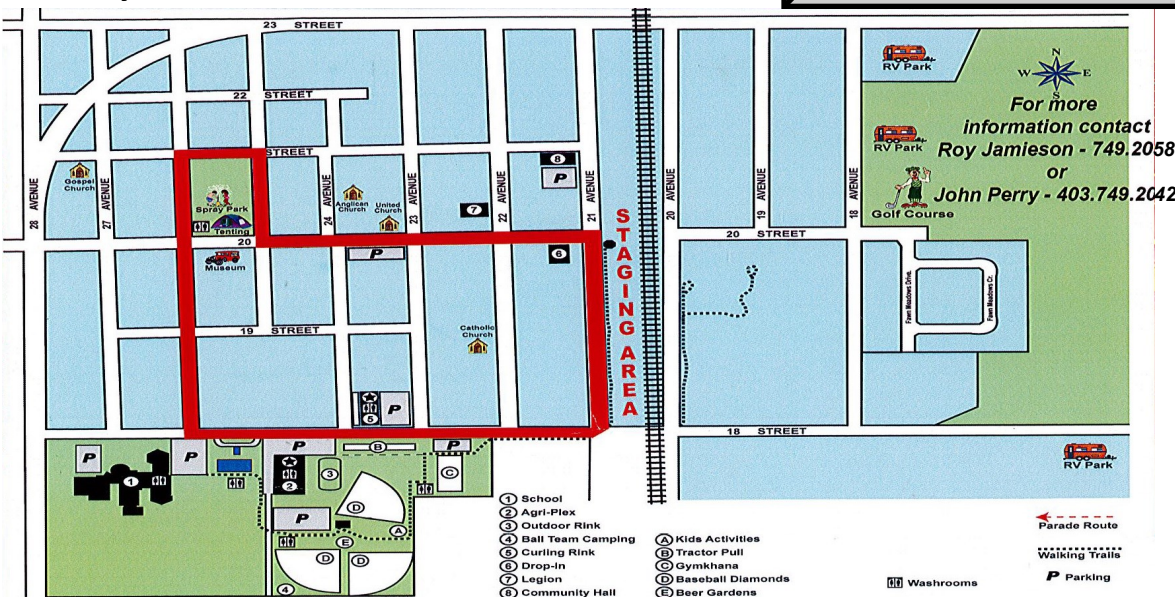

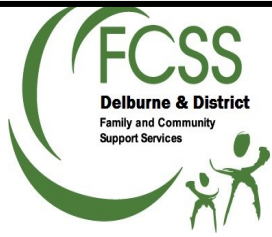
