Central Alberta Economic Partnership (CAEP) Business Representative

Policy Statement

Council recognizes the importance of having a regional economic partnership so that our region can flourish through the attraction of businesses. The region is also recognized across Canada as well as Internationally. Through the Central Alberta Economic Partnership, the Village of Delburne has one Council representative and one business representative that is authorized to attend CAEP meetings and events. This policy sets out the parameters of how the business representative will be chosen.

GENERAL

II. GENERAL POLICY PRINCIPLES

1. The Business Representative will be a person who owns a business within the Village of Delburne municipal boundaries and holds a current business license.
2. The term for the Business Representative will be three (3) years at which time they can reapply for the position.
3. Letters of application must be received by October 1 at the end of the three-year term and the next Business Representative will be chosen prior to Council's Organizational meeting which is the last Council meeting in October.
4. The Business Representative will keep Council up to date on anything pertinent from the CAEP Board activities by attending the next available Council meeting following the Spring and Fall General Meetings.




