

### Village of Delburne Golf Cart Bylaw Denied

In June, Delburne Council, along with Three Hills RCMP and Red Deer County Patrol, had a meeting about golf carts with a few residents who live around the Fawn Meadows Golf & Country Club. These



residents were seeking a bylaw to allow for golf carts to be driven on public roadways within Village limits. There was a lot of discussion from all parties about the pros and cons of allowing golf carts to be operated on public roadways.

After the meeting, Council made the decision to ask the Village's insurance company for their advice as well as get a legal opinion from our municipal lawyer.

The Village's insurance company has informed us that since golf carts are classified as miniature vehicles under the *Alberta Traffic Safety Act* and cannot be licensed and insured, the Village would assume all liability should something serious happen while a golf cart was being operated on the public roadway. The Village was also informed that if a golf cart bylaw was put in place, our liability insurance would not be valid. In this case, if a serious incident should happen, the Village would be involved in a lawsuit and the tax payers would be paying out of their pocket for all of the legal expenses and settlements instead of our insurance covering it.

When the municipality pursued a legal opinion, our lawyer affirmed that the Village would be at serious risk should Council approve a golf cart bylaw.

After obtaining these professional opinions, Council has decided not to pursue a golf cart bylaw as it puts the municipality and our stakeholders at too great of a risk. Council really hopes that everyone involved understands the reasoning behind this decision.

### Fees & Charges Bylaw Amended

Council passed Bylaw No. 1182/2022, the amended Fees & Charges Bylaw, at the July 19th meeting. The Recycling Curbside Pick-Up fee has increased to \$4.91 as per the contract renewal with E360s and the previously approved Yard Waste fee of \$1.50 has been added to the Bylaw.

Another addition, to the Bylaw, is a base fee of \$200 when Public Works must clear an unsightly yard. Labour and equipment fees will be added on top of the base fee.

The Application to Amend the Land Use Bylaw fee has increased from \$150 to \$300. This fee has been set at \$150 since its inception in 1997. Legislatively, the Village must advertise the application request and advertising fees have risen significantly.

## Municipal Newsletter Policy Passed

At the July 19th Council meeting, *Policy No. 1-024*, a Municipal Newsletter Policy, was passed in order to establish content submission guidelines for the Village Voice. This policy will apply to material submitted by non-profit organizations, community members, and businesses.

Here is a brief breakdown of the submission guidelines:

### General Information:

- The submission deadline is the 3rd Monday of the present month for the next month's edition. Late submissions will not be accepted.
- The preferred method to submit is with a digital file which is emailed to [villagevoice@delburne.ca](mailto:villagevoice@delburne.ca) but an original hardcopy can be dropped off at the Village Office.
- The Village reserves the right to approve or disapprove of any and all submissions it receives.

### Non-Profit Organizations:

- It is free to submit but a finished poster must be provided as the municipality will not offer design services. Non-profit organizations who are unable to create their own poster can seek assistance through Family & Community Support Services.
- Announcement criteria: A maximum count of 125 words and the text size must be a size 12 or larger.
- The maximum space granted for an announcement will be a quarter portion of an 8.5 x 11 inches letter-size page. Should a group wish to submit a larger announcement, they can provide the municipality with printed copies to be inserted into the newsletter. Please contact us for a current distribution count.

### Community Members:

- Community members can submit an announcement for a celebration event or a thank you message.
- The message must not exceed a maximum count of 80 words and it will be printed in text-only without images.

### Businesses:

- Businesses with a current Delburne Business License may purchase an advertisement. The current *Fees & Charges Bylaw* has the advertisement fees set as \$25 a month or \$250 for 12 months.
- The ad will be no larger than the size of a business card which is 3.5 x 2 inches. Please submit a completed advertisement as design services will not be provided by the municipality.

Do not leave expensive items lying around in your yard or driveway. Keep your shed & garage locked.

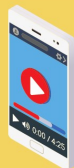


**Replace old locks, deadbolts and other aging security measures on all buildings.**

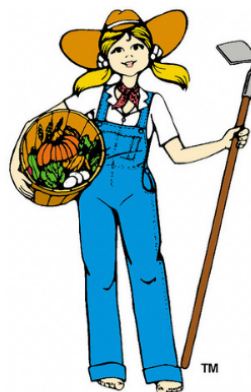
