## Answering Your Questions About Making Payments

**Can I send the Village an email money transfer?**

**No. Unfortunately our municipal banking system is not set up to accept email money transfers. We also have no way of rejecting a transfer if you send us one. Cancelling must be done on your end.**

**Why can't I pay online with my bank?**

**You can pay online if you bank with ATB, Servus, or Scotiabank as they do not charge us any fees to accept your payments. All other banks demand high fees for us to receive payments from them and we do not want to put those payments back on the taxpayer.**

**Can I pay my taxes using my utility account?**

**No. Tax and Utility account numbers are different. Please add both accounts to your online banking system as we must apply the payment to the account number provided from the bank statement.**

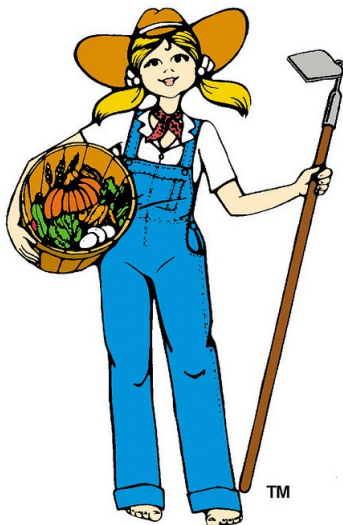

## RCMP YOUTH CAMP

The RCMP Youth Camp is a week-long free of charge summer camp for students in Grades 7 through 12.

Students selected for the RCMP Youth Camp form a co-ed group that is reflective of a typical RCMP cadet troop. By the end of the week-long camp, the group will develop a good understanding of the career possibilities offered by the RCMP. 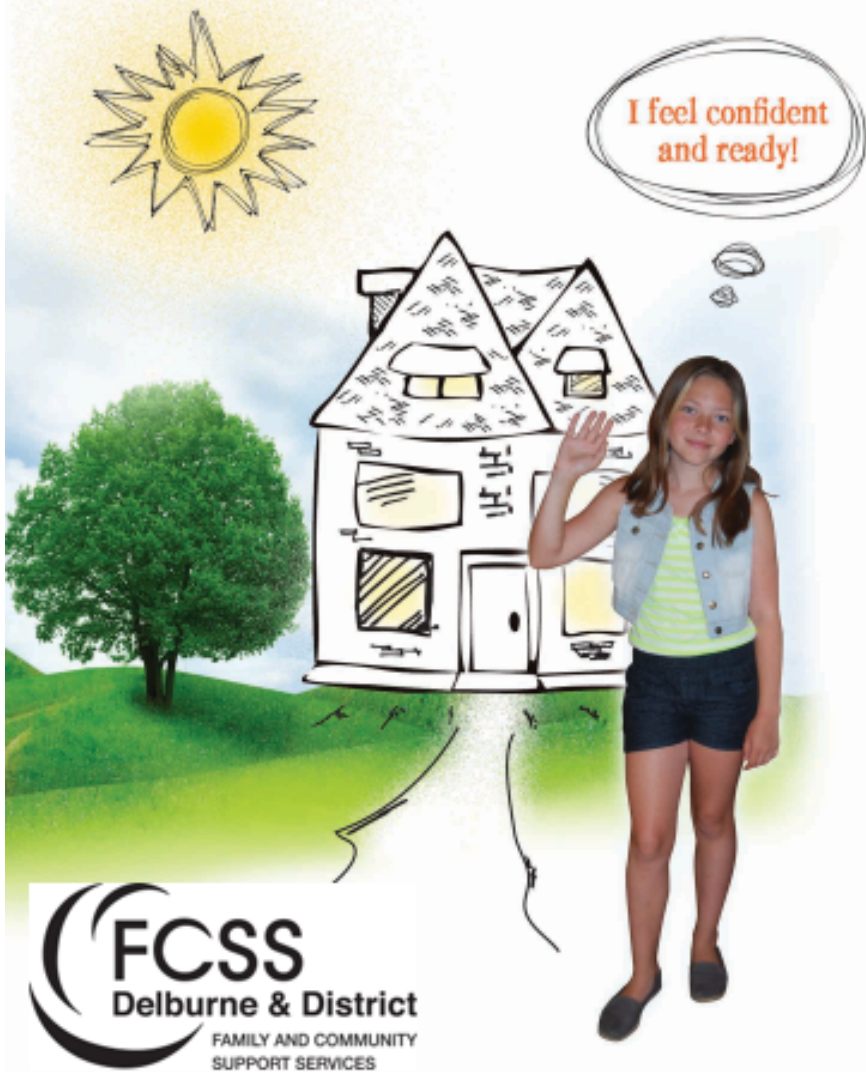
