

2023 Combined Assessment & Tax Notices

On May 5th, the 2023 Combined Assessment and Tax Notices were mailed out to property owners. Property taxes are due by June 30, 2023. After July 1st, a 15% late penalty will be applied to any outstanding balance on current taxes.

If you are signed up for pre-authorized payments, your new monthly payment is listed in the box at the bottom of your notice. Automatic withdrawals occur on the last day of the month.

In the May Village Voice, we stated that there was no increase to the general municipal levy, however we would like to provide some clarification about *Bylaw No. 1187/2023*, being the *2023 Tax Rate Bylaw*. The mill rates for residential and non-residential properties did not increase however the minimum amount payable for *general municipal purposes* was adjusted due to a legislated requirement in the Province of Alberta's *Municipal Government Act*.

In previous tax rate bylaws, there were five categories with five different minimum rates. This year, Council was required to set one rate as the minimum amount payable for *general municipal purposes* which has been set at \$600.00. For some property owners, this adjustment has resulted in an increase in the balance owing for taxes for 2023.

An increase in the balance owing may also be a result of a change in property assessment. If you have questions about your assessment, please contact the Village Assessor, Kevin Bohlken at 403-343-3357. Assessment complaint forms must be filed within 60 days from the assessment date and must be filed using the Government of Alberta "Assessment Review Board Complaint Form" which can be obtained at the Village office or www.alberta.ca/property-assessment-complaints-and-appeals.aspx.

Reminder of Public Hearing

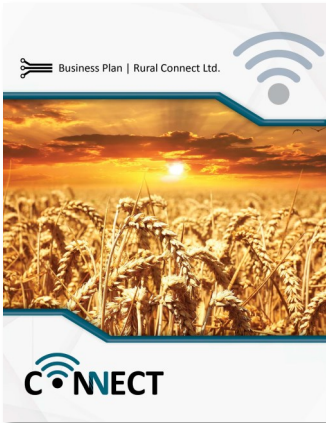

Properties South of Main St. (20th St.) should water on odd numbered days.
