

Delburne Thanks Dan Marsellus For His Service

The Village of Delburne would like to give a big thank you to Dan Marsellus for his service to our community over the past 11 years. Marsellus has given his resignations as the District Fire Chief for Delburne District and Deputy Director of Delburne’s Emergency Management Agency because he is



moving away. Marsellus has been an integral part of emergency management and fire services for Delburne. He was the Director of Emergency Management from June 2012 to September 2022 and held the position of Deputy Director of Emergency Management from September 2022 to June 2023.

Delburne’s Emergency Management Agency plans and prepares for the safety of our community in an event of an emergency or disaster. A team of municipal staff and council, emergency services members, citizens as well as representatives from neighbouring municipalities

Marsellus served 9 years with Fire Services meet to train for situations such as a tornado, train derailment, fire, etc. In 2016, Marsellus led the municipality in a successful full scale emergency exercise which tested the team’s training with various scenarios such as two structural collapses, a school bus roll-over, and operating a reception centre.

Marsellus worked his way up through the ranks of the fire department from 2014 to 2023, eventually holding the position of District Fire Chief. He was involved with the Red Deer Search & Rescue team from 1996 to 2001 and a member of the Red Deer County Technical Rescue Task Force from 2012 to 2018.

Prior to moving to Delburne, Marsellus served 16 years in the Canadian Armed Forces with four peacekeeping tours in Iran/Iraq (1988), Germany (1989), the Gulf War (1990/1991), and Golan Heights (1996/1997). He was awarded with a declaration for 12 years of military

service and in December 2022, he was awarded the Queen Elizabeth II Platinum Jubilee Medal.

Dan Marsellus has been an excellent leader in our community who will be greatly missed.

We thank him for his years of service to both our country and our community. Dan, we wish you all best in your future endeavours!
