2024 Property Tax Assessments and Notices

This year, the Village of Delburne Property Tax Assessments and Notices will be sent out separately rather than being combined. This action will assist in making the budget more accurate as the 60 day assessment appeal period will be over before tax notices are due.

The Village will be given the assessments by February 28th and property owners will receive them in early March. Council will set the 2024 tax rate in April and in mid-May tax notices will be mailed to property owners. Property taxes will be due by June 30th with a 15% late penalty applied on July 1st.

2024 Property Tax Payment Programs

4% Discount Program

Receive a 4% discount on the Municipal Levy by paying your 2024 taxes in full between January 1 - 31.

This discount is based on the previous year's levy and will be adjusted prior to taxes being levied in May 2024. The 4% discount **cannot** be applied to the Provincial requisitions which are the Seniors Foundation, School, and Police levies.

Monthly Payment Program

Pay monthly by cheque or automatic withdrawal

Cheques are deposited on the 15th of every month

- Sign-up by Wednesday, January 10, 2024

Automatic withdrawals occur on the last day of the month

- Sign-up by Tuesday, January 23, 2024

To participate in the 4% discount or monthly payment program, please book an appointment to fill out and sign paperwork.

For the monthly payment program, please provide a void cheque or an automatic withdrawal form from your bank.

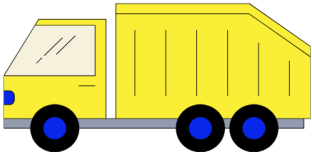

the curbside by 7 am.

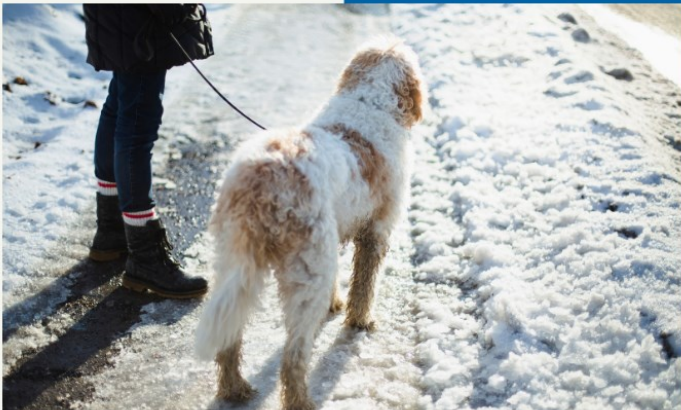
Please place items in a

Is your toilet running? Consider repairing it as soon as possible.

A leaky toilet can waste up to 600+ cubic metres of water a month or 20 cubic metres a day. The flapper valve is the most common cause of running toilets.

To check, place food colouring in the back of the tank. Do not flush. Wait & watch for 10 minutes. If colour seeps into the toilet bowl, then you have a leak.

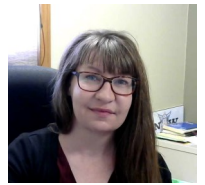

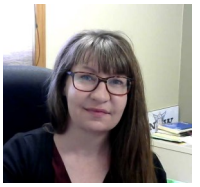

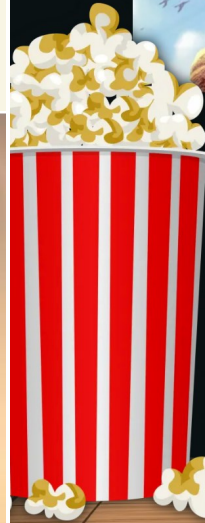
