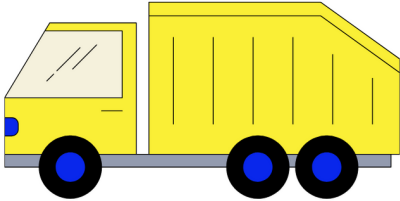

Three Hills RCMP Detachment

Reporting a Motor Vehicle Collision

As of January 1, 2024, the threshold for reporting motor vehicle collisions to the police has increased from \$2000 to \$5000.

If you are involved in a motor vehicle collision, you are only required to report it to the police if the total damage (vehicles and property) is \$5000 or more. If the combined damage totals less than \$5000, you no longer are required to report the collision.

When reporting, be prepared to provide your driver's license
and your vehicle's insurance and registration.
