

## March is Fraud Prevention Month

According to the Canadian Anti-Fraud Centre, 41,111 people were victims of fraud, losing \$554 million dollars in 2023. March is Fraud Prevention Month which is an annual campaign that helps you recognize, reject, and report fraud. This year's theme, "20 years of fighting fraud: From then to now" will help Canadians recognize how fraud has evolved over the years, from telemarketing and mail to social media and Artificial Intelligence.

Scammers target everyone. They are good at manipulating people to get what they want, such as getting you to reveal personal information or convincing you to give them money. The best way to avoid becoming a victim of fraud is to be informed and vigilant. Take a moment to think before parting with your money or information. Get to know the different types of scams and always report instances of fraud to the RCMP (403-443-5538) and the Canadian Anti-Fraud Centre (1-888-495-8501). 1. Hang up and never provide personal banking or payment information to someone who has contacted you by phone.
2. Resist the pressure to act immediately. Legitimate businesses will give you time to make a decision. Anyone who pressures you to pay or give them your personal information is most likely a scammer.
3. If you have any questions about your account, call the ATCO Electric call centre at 1-800-668-2248.
4. If you get a suspicious call, report the incident to the RCMP and the Canadian Anti-Fraud Centre at 1-888-495-8501.
