

Central Alberta Municipalities Sign Emergency Management Agreement

The Red Deer Regional Emergency Management Partnership Agreement was signed on February 14, 2024 by elected officials from Bowden, Delburne, Elnora, Innisfail, Penhold, Red Deer, Red Deer County and Sylvan Lake. This agreement formalizes the support and cooperation that has been happening for years. Through this partnership, the municipalities have formed the Red Deer Regional Emergency Management Agency which will meet twice a year to review and amend the Red Deer Regional Emergency Management Plan. The Agency will ensure that appropriate resources, equipment and training are provided to manage and recover from emergencies and disasters.

Village of Delburne Municipal Office is Closed on April 29th & 30th

Delburne Council has moved to close the Village office on Monday, April 29th and Tuesday, April 30th so that municipal staff can take ICS 200, an emergency management training course. The Village is legislated under Alberta's *Emergency Management Act* to plan and prepare for the safety of our community in an event of an emergency.

Citizens wishing to make payments on April 29th & 30th can place cash or a cheque in an envelope through the mail slot of the Village Office door. Alternatively, payments can be made through ATB Financial, Servus Credit Union, or Scotiabank. Drought Conditions in Alberta

Many areas are dealing with drought conditions so the Government of Alberta has implemented a Water Shortage Management Response Plan. Currently, the Province is in stage 4, out of 5 stages.

Stage 1: Monitoring & Observation

Stage 2: Active Management

Stage 3: Priority Call Assessment and Administration

Stage 4: Multiple Water Management Areas Affected

Stage 5: Declaring an Emergency under the Water Act

The Government of Alberta is working with water license holders, such as the Village of Delburne, to help find solutions. Depending on the length and severity of a water shortage, the Government of Alberta may proceed through these 5 stages. For more information visit: www.alberta.ca/drought-101

Delburne Council, Staff, and Delburne's Emergency Management Agency are working together to plan and prepare for further drought conditions.

Delburne's *Water Restriction Policy #1-016* was passed over 20 years ago, on May 27, 2003, to conserve water and lessen the strain on our pumphouse and wells. Watering restrictions are in effect from May 1 to September 1 of each year with properties on the north side of Main St. watering on even numbered days and properties on the south side watering on odd numbered days. Last year, water restrictions were increased to watering in the evenings due the extensive combined water consumption and lack of precipitation.

As we prepare for another year of drought, we are asking citizens to be mindful of their water usage both indoors and outdoors. Beginning May 1st, the Rain Barrel Rebate Program returns which offers a one-time credit of \$50.00 on your utility bill when you purchase a brand new rain barrel.

Acceptable items: paper, cardboard, aluminum cans and plastics with symbols #1 to #7.


All items must be clean. No glass, plastic bags, or styrofoam.


