Delburne Council has made the decision to close the Main Street Park Campground. Water and electrical services are in need of repairs and the high cost to fix them is not cost effective with the low utilization of the campground. Council will explore options for a better use of the public space.

Any person in violation of the *Water Restrictions Policy* will be subject to penalties as set in the new *Water, Sewer, & Garbage Bylaw* (No. 1197/2024).

## Stage 3 - Reduce Non-Essential Water Use

- Enforcement with automatic fine.
- Watering lawns, trees, shrubs, & gardens on designated days and times for a maximum of 1/2 hour per day.
- No filling of pools, hot tubs, or water features. Topping up is permitted.






