Road Safety Reminders

Pay attention to the posted 30 km/hr speed limits.

When a school bus is flashing its alternate red lights, STOP!
Never pass a school bus when the signal lights are flashing.

Look out for children, especially during school operating hours. Children can become easily distracted and unaware of their surroundings.

When pedestrians are crossing the street, come to a complete stop.

Do not block the crosswalk with your vehicle. Wait until all pedestrians have cleared the road before proceeding.

Village of Delburne Water Restrictions May 1st - October 1st

Water Restrictions Policy - Stage 3: Reduce Non-Essential Water Use

- Enforcement with automatic fine.
- Watering lawns, trees, shrubs, & gardens on designated days and times for a maximum of **30 minutes per day**.
- No pressure washing of vehicles, surfaces, or buildings.
- No filling of pools, hot tubs, or water features. Topping up is permitted.



EVEN NUMBERED ADDRESSES ARE PERMITTED TO WATER ON EVEN DAYS OF THE MONTH

ODD NUMBERED ADDRESSES ARE PERMITTED TO WATER ON ODD DAYS OF THE MONTH

WATERING IS ONLY PERMITTED BETWEEN 6:00 PM AND 10:00 PM

Any person in violation of the *Water Restrictions Policy 1-014* will be subject to penalties as set in the *Water, Sewer, & Garbage Bylaw No. 1197/2024*.

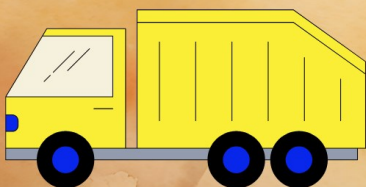
