FIRE RESTRICTION ORDER LIFTED

As of 10:00 am today August 29, 2024, the fire restriction for the Village of Delburne has been lifted.

Permits are now available online at rdcounty.ca/fire. Please set-up your account to obtain a burn permit. A reminder that a fire permit is required for all open fires year-round, except for safe acceptable residential fire pits*, within Red Deer County and the Village of Delburne.

Fire Services will continue to monitor weather patterns. Should dry weather conditions return another fire restriction may be put in place.

*Safe acceptable residential fire pits -

- a. A minimum of 3 meters clearance, measured from the nearest fire pit edge to the nearest edge of building, property line, or other combustible material;
- b. A height not exceeding 0.6 meters when measured from the surrounding grade to the top of the pit opening;
- c. Equipped with a mesh screen with opening no larger than 12.5mm;
- d. Enclosed sides made from bricks, concrete blocks, heavy gauge metal, or other non-combustible materials; and
- e. Not located over any underground utilities or under any above ground wires.
