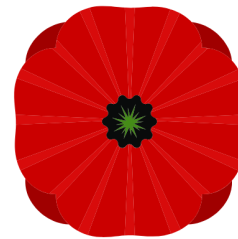
Our last meeting of 2024 will be on November 27th at 7:00 pm at the Legion.

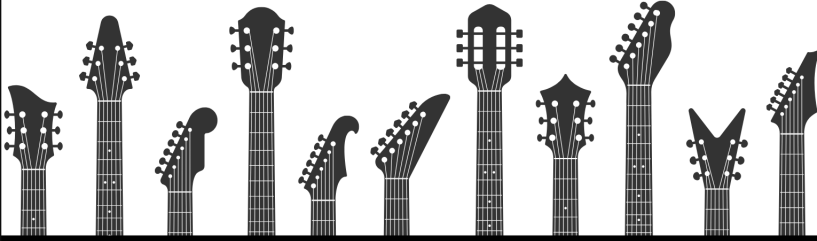
