A couple of additional things you may want to consider are:

Contact the current Mayor and/or Councillors to talk about their time commitment, the tasks and issues they are currently involved with, and what Council needs to undertake in the future. Councillors not only serve on the Village Council, but are required to serve on a number of committees and boards in which the Village has an interest. These boards include, but are not limited to, Red Deer and Delburne Family and Community Social Services (FCSS), Central Alberta Economic Partnership (CAEP), Parkland Regional Library and Delburne Municipal Library, Parkland Community Planning, Parkland Foundation, and Community Action Committee.

Contact the CAO to arrange a meeting to review what has been on the agendas of the previous few months of Council or review minutes. *(This will assist you in coming up to speed with what Council has been addressing and what tasks are facing Council.)*
