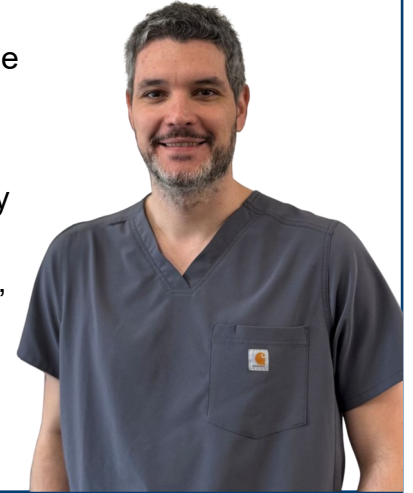


## Delburne Welcomes Doctor Del Papa

## Golf Cart Pilot Project

The Village will be participating in the Government of Alberta's *Golf Cart Pilot Project* which will allow permit holders to drive their golf cart on the roadway from their house to Fawn Meadows Golf & Country Club. To receive a permit, a person must live in the designated area, have a valid driver's license, and be able to provide proof of \$2 million dollars of liability insurance. The permit will cost \$60 plus GST and it must be displayed on the windshield of the golf cart. The permit will be valid for one calendar year, expiring on December 31st.



The designated area for the *Pilot Project* is the east side of the railway tracks on 18th Ave, 19th Ave, 20th Street, Fawn Meadows Drive, and Fawn Meadows Crescent. Golf carts are not permitted to cross the railway tracks and they cannot be driven after dark.

Permit holders must follow the rules of Alberta's *Traffic Safety Act*, Alberta's *Pilot Project (Golf Carts) Regulation* and Village of Delburne *Bylaw No. 1202/2024*, being the *Golf Cart Pilot Project Bylaw*.

- Interviews will take place in May.

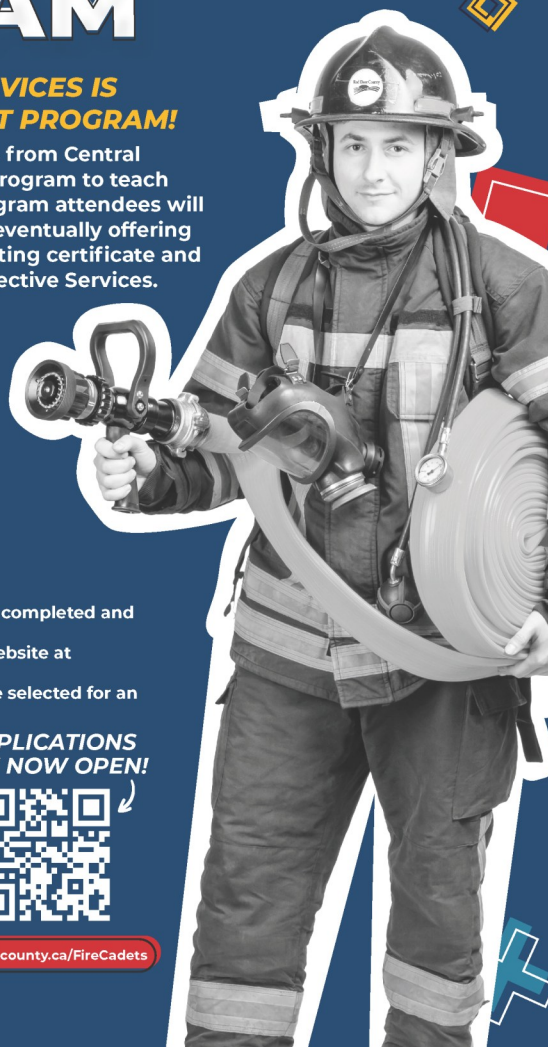

The term of office for Council is 4 years: October 2025 to October 2029.

To be an eligible candidate:

- Must be at least 18 years old

## Are you making online banking payments to the correct account?

The Village of Delburne will apply a payment to the account given on your bank's remittance statement, so please double check whether you are intending to pay your property tax account or utility account.

Property Tax accounts begin with 083 + 5 digits: e.g. **083 012430**. For your property tax account, you can either put in all 8 digits or the last 5 digits.

Utility accounts have 11 digits: e.g. **000 01234 001**. When adding your utility account to your online banking system, add the last 8 digits: e.g. **01234 001**. The last **3 digits** (example 000 or 001) are important as it indicates that it is a utility account. If we receive payment to a **5 digit** account, it signifies that the payment is for the property tax account.

Please double check that you have selected the right account before making an online banking payment.

## Reduce Unnecessary Water Usage

### Check your toilet for leaks!

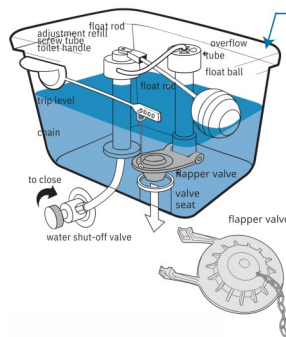
A leaky toilet can use up to 20 cubic metres of water a day. A stuck or damaged flapper valve is the most common cause of a running toilet.

### Test your toilet!

Place food colouring in the back of the tank. Do not flush.

Wait and watch for 10 minutes.

If the colour seeps into the toilet bowl then you have a leak.
