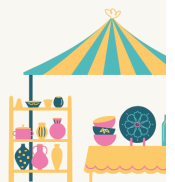
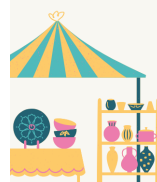

# Village of Delburne Outdoor Water Restrictions

Outdoor water restrictions are in effect from May 1<sup>st</sup> to October 1<sup>st</sup> every year as outlined in the Water Restrictions Policy No. 1-014. There are 4 stages of restrictions which are defined by specific metrics or triggers in relation to our water supply. Currently, Stage 1 is in effect but that is subject to change. Please monitor our website, Facebook page, and Village signage for updates.

## Stage 1: Monitoring & Observation

- Watering lawns, trees, shrubs, & gardens on designated days and times.
- No restrictions for filling of pools, hot tubs, or water features.
- No restrictions for cleaning outdoor services
- It is recommended that vehicles be washed at a commercial car wash.

**WATERING IS ONLY PERMITTED BETWEEN 6:00 PM AND 10:00 PM**

### **Safe Acceptable Fire Pit**

A minimum of 3 metres clearance, measured from the nearest fire pit edge to the nearest edge of the building, property line, or combustible material.

A height not exceeding 0.6 metres when measured from the surrounding grade to the top of the pit opening.

Equipped with a mesh screen, with an opening no larger than 12.5 mm.

Enclosed sides made from bricks, concrete blocks, heavy gauge metal, or other non-combustible materials.

Not located over any underground utilities or under any above ground wires.
