Letters and delegation appointments for the meeting agenda must be submitted/booked at least **7 days** prior to the next meeting.

Village Voice Submissions: The deadline for the next issue is the **third Monday** of the current month. Submissions must meet the requirements as outlined in the *Municipal Newsletter Policy*. Please submit by emailing villagevoice@delburne.ca or drop off your poster at the Village Office.

Are you interested in running for Delburne Council?



On Election Day, October 20, 2025, Delburne residents will be voting for 5 Councillors. The elected Councillors will then choose the Mayor.

The term on Council is 4 years: October 2025 to October 2029.

Nomination packages are available at the Village Office and online at www.delburne.ca/election.

A Councillor will:

- Have the opportunity to significantly influence the future of the Village of Delburne
- Assume a leadership role to represent citizens
- Provide direction on policies and service levels of programs offered by the municipality

To be an eligible candidate:

- Must be at least 18 years old
- A Canadian citizen
- Have been a Delburne resident for 6 consecutive months prior to September 22, 2025.

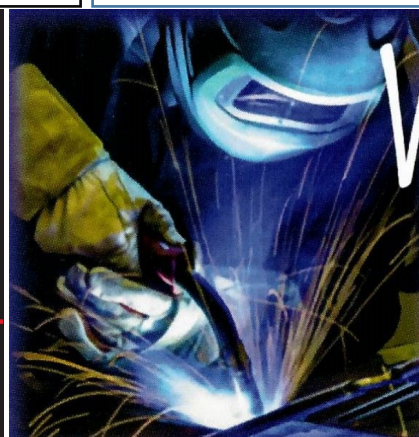

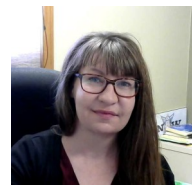
