To be an eligible candidate:

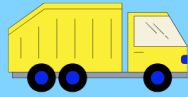
- Must be at least 18 years old

The *National Day for Truth and Reconciliation* is September 30th.

The *Day* honours the children who never returned home and the survivors of residential schools, as well as their families and communities.



The *Survivors' Flag* will be raised at the Village office during the last week of September. The *Survivors' Flag* is an expression of remembrance, meant to honour residential school survivors and all of the lives and communities impacted by the residential school system in Canada.

The Village office will be closed from 11 am to 2 pm on Tuesday, September 30th so that staff and Council can commemorate the *National Day for Truth and Reconciliation*. We will also be wearing orange shirts for *Orange Shirt Day* which is the legacy of the St. Joseph Mission Residential School Commemoration Project. The Orange Shirt Society was founded by Phyllis (Jack) Webstad, a residential school survivor, and others, to create awareness of the intergenerational impacts of residential schools and promote the concept of "Every Child Matters."
