From December 1, 2025, to December 15, 2025, Three Hills RCMP responded to 80 events/calls for service. These included various levels of criminal, traffic and public assistance related files. Below is a variety of calls for service received and investigations conducted by the Three Hills RCMP:

Hit and Run

On December 2, 2025, at 9:22 PM, Three Hills RCMP received a report of a hit and run collision on Highway 583 in Kneehill County. The complainant informed police he was hit by a truck while he was driving on the highway. The truck had crossed the centre line into the oncoming traffic lane and, when it re-entered the proper lane, the complainant struck its rear bumper. The truck did not stop after the collision.

Weapon for dangerous purpose

On December 5, 2025, at 3:32 PM, Three Hills RCMP investigated a male believed to be experiencing a mental health crisis. Police located the male at his residence in Trochu and observed what appeared to a revolver and knife in his possession. The

male refused to exit, and a warrant to enter his residence was obtained. Three Hills RCMP contained the residence, including the area around it and, with the assistance of negotiators, Police Dog Services and the Emergency Response Team, safely arrested the male.

Police located an airgun revolver and a knife inside the male's residence. He was released into the care of the hospital. The area where the male's residence was located posed significant danger to the public, and Three Hills RCMP would like to thank all those who cooperated with the high-risk situation.

A charge for possession of a weapon for a dangerous purpose will be submitted to the Crown for approval against a 70-year-old male from Trochu.

Flight from Police

On December 7, 2025, Three Hills RCMP investigated an impaired and prohibited driver who was failing to comply with his release conditions. Police located the male behind the wheel of a truck and, when they attempted to speak with him, he used the truck to ram a police vehicle and evade arrest. The male drove in a dangerous manner while fleeing from police in the rural area of Kneehill County.

Police later located the male in the truck parked on his rural property. Police secured the male into custody after he physically resisted. The male was brought to the Three Hills RCMP detachment, where he refused to provide samples of his breath. He was later remanded into custody after completion of a bail hearing.

A 38-year-old male from Kneehill County has been charged with the following:

- Operation while prohibited
- Assault on police officer
- Dangerous operation of motor vehicle
- Flight from peace officer
- Resist/obstruct peace officer
- Operation while impaired
- Refusal to comply with demand
- Fail to comply with probation order
- Fail to comply with release order conditions

Assault with a weapon

On December 11, 2025, at 4:05 PM, Three Hills RCMP received a report of a domestic dispute between a male and female at a residence in Trochu. Police investigated and learned a female had slashed a male across the chest with a knife a few days prior to

the argument. The female was arrested, and she was later released on a Release Order with conditions by a Justice of the Peace after completion of a bail hearing.

A 32-year-old female from Trochu has been charged with assault with a weapon.

She is scheduled to appear at the Drumheller Court of Justice on December 19, 2025.

Public Education and Awareness

Crime Stoppers

Crime Stoppers allows for people to anonymously report crimes and provide information to the police. The public can often be the key to advancing an investigation or identifying a suspect and/or person of interest. Tips from the public can lead to the arrest of a criminal, recovery of stolen property, and the seizure of illegal drugs and weapons.

Three Hills RCMP utilizes, when appropriate, the media to assist in investigations. Surveillance images and requests for assistance are disseminated, and the public has been instrumental in providing police with tips and information.

If you have information about a criminal offence or about criminal activity, Three Hills RCMP encourages the use of Crime Stoppers. Often, people do not wish to come forward because they do not want a suspect to be aware of them or because they do not wish to take part in court proceedings. Crime Stoppers provides the public with a way to report to police while remaining anonymous and safe from any feared reprisal from those involved in criminal activity.
