

### The Yard Waste Trailer is Not a Garbage Disposal Service

The yard waste trailer is a seasonal service to dispose of grass clippings, weeds, leaves, and small branches. The trailer rotates to different locations throughout the Village each day, making it easier for residents who cannot transport yard waste to the Delburne Eco Station.

On May 11th, the trailer was taken out of service for a week following a second incident of garbage dumping since the service launched on May 4th. Improper use of the yard waste trailer creates unnecessary cleanup costs and takes significant staff time to manage. Recently dumped items, such as lawn furniture, plastic bags, planters, and household waste, do not belong in the trailer. Please take your bags or containers with you after disposing of yard waste. Help keep this service available by following the guidelines.



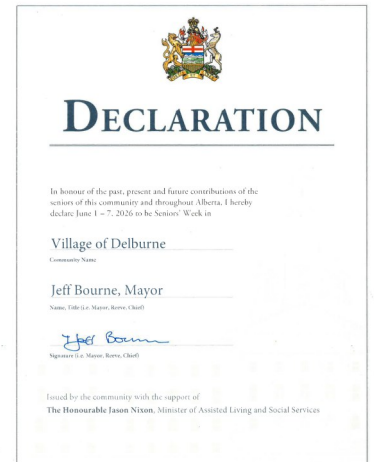
Letters and delegations for the meeting agenda must be submitted/booked at least **7 days** prior to the next meeting.

## Delburne Declares June 1 to 7 as Seniors' Week

This year, Alberta proudly celebrates the 40th anniversary of Seniors' Week. Inspired by the vision of the late Alice Modin, Seniors' Week has been recognized since 1986 to celebrate the contributions seniors make to enhance the quality of life in Alberta. Modin began a campaign to start a seniors' day in Strathcona County that helped pave the way for this annual event.

## Property Tax Payments are due June 30, 2026

Property Tax notices were mailed on May 7, 2026. If you did not receive your notice, please contact the Village Office at 403-749-3606 or [village@delburne.ca](mailto:village@delburne.ca).

Payment is due on or before June 30, 2026.

A 15% penalty will be applied on July 1, 2026.

Payment can be made by the following options:

- Debit, cash, or cheque at the Village Office during business hours. We also take credit card but a 3% user fee is applied.
- Cheque, made out to 'Village of Delburne'. Mail it to Box 341, Delburne AB T0M 0V0 or after hours, place it through the mail slot of the Village Office front door.
- Through these banking institutions: ATB Financial, Scotiabank, & Servus Credit Union. These are the only 3 banks that do not charge service fees to the municipality.
  - Property tax accounts begin with 083 + 5 digits e.g. 083 01234. You can either put in all 8 digits or the last 5 digits of the account number.
  - Double check that you have selected your property tax account and not your utility account when making a property tax payment.
- Credit card through OptionPay. A 3% user fee is applied. <https://payment.optionpay.ca/village-of-delburne/index.php>

Even numbered addresses are permitted to water on even days of the month between 6 pm to 10 pm

Odd numbered addresses are permitted to water on odd days of the month between 6 pm to 10 pm

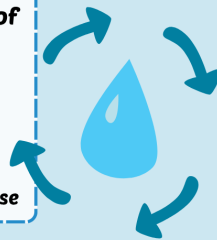
The Water Restrictions Policy No. 1-014 outlines 4 stages of restrictions which are defined by specific metrics or triggers in relation to our water supply.

Stage 1: Water Conservation

Stage 2: Reduce Water Use

Stage 3: Reduce Non-Essential Water Use

Stage 4: Emergency Water Shortage & Stop All Non-Essential Water Use



### We are currently in Stage 1: Water Conservation

- Watering lawns, trees, shrubs, & gardens on designated days and times.
- No restrictions for filling of pools, hot tubs, or water features.
- No restrictions for cleaning outdoor surfaces.
- It is recommended that vehicles are washed at a commercial car wash.

Residents who have installed and are watering new sod are asked to contact the Village Office at 403-749-3606 or [village@delburne.ca](mailto:village@delburne.ca). This helps us track short-term increases in water usage.

### Village of Delburne Fire Services Bylaw No. 1133/2017



#### Safe Acceptable Fire Pit

- A minimum of 3 metres clearance, measured from the nearest fire pit edge to the nearest edge of the building, property line, or combustible material.
- A height not exceeding 0.6 metres when measured from the surrounding grade to the top of the pit opening.
- Equipped with a mesh screen, with an opening no larger than 12.5 mm.
- Enclosed sides made from bricks, concrete blocks, heavy gauge metal, or other non-combustible materials.
- Not located over any underground utilities or under any above ground wires.

**No burning of garbage, animal manure, or treated wood**

Yes, if you are installing a pool, larger than 600 mm (1.96 ft) deep, or a hot tub, you need a building permit.

The reason is to due to potential structural loading, if it is going on a deck. Another reason is to ensure that fences, locked covers, gates, and other restricted access safety measures are constructed.



*Are you aware of the Difference between a Community Navigator and a Community Facilitator?*

### Community Navigators

FCSS Community Navigators provide direct services to the community or empower the local community to take action on broader community social matters. They also act as information and referral agents to ensure that residents are connected with appropriate social services within the region

### Community Facilitators

FCSS Community Facilitators provide consultative and facilitative leadership and support and are rarely involved in direct service delivery. They focus largely on community capacity building through convening and/or contributing to broad social issues that are not owned by any one agency. Their roles range from advocate, educator, capacity builder, convener to coordinator.
