

BYLAW NO. 1217/2026
Land Use Bylaw Amendment

**Being a Bylaw of the Village of Delburne, in the Province of Alberta,
to amend Land Use Bylaw No. 1190/2023.**

WHEREAS, Section 639 of the Municipal Government Act, Revised Statutes of Alberta 2000, Chapter M-26 and amendments thereto, provides that every municipality must pass a Land Use Bylaw;

AND WHEREAS, the Municipal Government Act, Revised Statutes of Alberta 2000, Chapter M-26 and amendments thereto, permit a Council to amend the Land Use Bylaw;

AND WHEREAS, it is deemed necessary and expedient to amend Land Use Bylaw No. 1190/2023 of the Village of Delburne in the manner hereinafter appearing;

NOW THEREFORE, the Municipal Council of the Village of Delburne, in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled and under the powers conferred upon it by the Municipal Government Act, Revised Statutes of Alberta 2000, Chapter M-26 and amendments thereto, enacts as follows:

1. THAT Part Seven (7) of the Land Use Bylaw, section 7.1 include day care facilities in the discretionary uses section.
